The following information in respect of the Karnataka State Police Complaints Authority ('Authority' in short) is hereby published under Section 4(1)(b) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 ('Act' in short):

1. The Particular of its organisation, functions and duties:

(a) The Authority is constituted by the Government of Karnataka under Section 20C (1) of the Karnataka Police Act, 1963 ('Act' in short). Its composition is as follows:

- (i) A retired High Court Judge as Chairman
- (ii) A retired civil servant, not below the rank of Principal Secretary to Government, as a member
- (iii) A member from Civil Society
- (iv) A woman IPS Officer not below the rank of Deputy Inspector General of Police as a member, and
- (v) Additional Director General of Police (Grievance) as a Member and Member-Secretary.

(b) Its functions and duties are as stipulated under Section 20C of the Act.

(c) The present incumbents are as follows:

- (i) Chairman: Justice (Retd.) Shri M.P. Chinnappa, Former Judge of the High Court of Karnataka
- (ii) Member: Shri Abhay Prakash, I.A.S. (Retd.), Former Additional Chief Secretary and Development Commissioner, Government of Karnataka

- (iii) Member: Dr. Sudarshan.H.Ballal, (subject to the judgment in W.P. 32054 of 2014)
- (iv) Member: Smt. Malini Krishnamoorthy, I.P.S., Inspector General of Police, Karnataka State Reserve Police
- (v) Member and Member-Secretary: Shri Sanjay Sahay, I.P.S., Additional Director General of Police

(d) It is located at room Nos. 36 and 37, Vikasa Soudha, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Vedhi, Bangalore-560 001. Office Phone no. is 080-22386063.

2. The powers and duties of its officers and employees:

The Deputy Secretary, under the general supervision of the Member-Secretary and overall supervision of the Chairman, is in-charge of the functioning of the office of the Authority which, inter alia, includes follow up action on the decisions of the Authority and assigning the work to the staff in General Section. The Section Officer in the establishment of the Chairman is in-charge of processing of the files of the complaints for the consideration of the Authority, post-decision processing, maintenance of records and any other work assigned by the Chairman. The duty of the staff in the personal sections of the Chairman and Member is to carry out the work related to the respective personal establishments.

3. The procedure followed in the decision making process, including channels of supervision and accountability:

It is laid down in the Karnataka State Police Complaints Authority (Procedure) Regulations, 2014.

4. The norms set by it for the discharge of its functions:

The Authority acts as per Section 20C of the Act.

5. The rules, regulations, instructions, manuals and records held by it or under its control:

- (i) Karnataka Police Complaints Authority (Procedure) Regulations, 2014
 - (ii) Rules and standing instructions of the government applicable to service conditions of the Chairman, members, officers and the staff of the Authority.

- (i) Files dealing with complaints under Section 20C of the Act.
 - (ii) Files dealing with meetings of the Authority
 - (iii) Files dealing with other general and accounts matters
 - (iv) Registers relating to the above mentioned matters

- The work of this Authority does not involve policy formulation.
